

From the Editors Desk

April- June 2019 issue would be the last month for which the print copies of Indian Journal of Medical Microbiology (IJMM) will be sent to all members of Indian Association of Medical Microbiology (IAMM). From July – September 2019 issue onwards we will be sending print copies of the journal to only Medknow subscribers. All IAMM members will start receiving the electronic versions (e-copy) of the journal, and their print copies would stop.

With electronic revolution, most organizations dependent earlier on paper have gradually shifted to electronic formats. IJMM is also working on theme of Digital India and aiming to make the working paperless. Other purpose of this exercise is to reduce the number of printed copies to cut down on high cost and logistics involved in printing 5,000 plus copies every three months. With more than half of the members having not updated their addresses as a result the print copies would be returned or wasted. Moreover, the request of address update to members received a lukewarm response; this has been leading to the waste of resources of IAMM. Hence we decided to make the electronic version as the default option, and send print copies to only Medknow subscribers.

Before we make the electronic formats as the default option, the main task for the journal office was to inform all the 5000 plus members. Kindly, note that the journal will be available freely in digital format for all IAMM members, which can be easily accessed on electronic devices. The members those who are not familiar with accessing the journal online here are the steps that need to be followed

1. Type the title of the journal “Indian Journal of Medical Microbiology” in your search engine or start with <http://www.ijmm.org/> in the web browser



2. Scroll through the results page until you locate the correct title
